The Mid-Atlantic Chapter of the International Society of Arboriculture (MAC-ISA) is offering academic scholarships in memory of Dr. Frank Santamour, past President and charter member of the Mid-Atlantic Chapter of ISA. MAC-ISA is offering two scholarships in the amount of \$1250.00 to be awarded in the spring of 2018 for the fall semester. These scholarship(s) will be awarded **to undergraduate** students studying arboriculture/urban forestry or a related field who have a genuine interest in a career in arboriculture. The students need to be a member of MAC-ISA to apply (only \$25 for membership). The scholarships will be available to two and four year colleges and universities that have committed programs in horticulture, arboriculture and/or urban forestry.
